



Beaches & Boulders

Mumbai – Goa – Hampi
7 days 6 nights

Day 1 - Arrive in Mumbai and enjoy a free afternoon exploring the art deco suburb of historical Colaba. Stroll down past the night markets to the famous Taj Hotel by the Gateway of India and take a horse drawn carriage to enjoy a unique view of the harbour.

Day 2. In the morning take a walk around the heritage streets of Colaba visiting the innovative Jehangir Art gallery and the Prince of Wales museum. After lunch have a half day tour to see the Washing Dhobi's, Jain Temple, the views from Malabar Hill, and Mahatma Gandhi's house before ending the day enjoying the sunset on Chowpatty Beach before dinner.

Overnight Mumbai

Day 3 – Taking a morning flight to Goa to stay in a hotel close to the beach. Enjoy a massage and some shopping ending the day watching the sunset over the Arabian Sea while you enjoy a world famous Goan fish curry with a nice cold beer.

Day 4 – A day tour of Old Goa with it's historical cathedrals, a Hindu temple set in the paddy fields, ending the day in Portuguese style Panaji with a sunset dinner cruise on the Mandovi River.

Day 5 – Enjoy a picturesque train ride up the Western Ghats to Hospet and from there transfer to Hampi.

Overnight Hampi

Day 6 – A morning guided tour to explore the ancient ruins of Hampi, the site of the most amazing architectural ruins of an ancient civilization. A super chilled place where you can cycle and walk easily. Stroll down and take a coracle boat ride on the river or just chat to the friendly locals.

Dec 7 – An early morning departure to drive to Hubli airport to fly to MUMBAI.
