



Tea & Coconuts

Cochin, Munnar, Alleppey
7 days 6 nights

Day 1. Arrive in Cochin to start the tour. Transfer to hotel in Fort Cochin. Free day to relax from traveling.

Day 2. Have a day tour of this delightful harbour town with its Portuguese churches and funky shops. Indulge yourself with a genuine Keralan massage. See the Chinese fishing nets at sunset and experience the Kathikali Dance Show before dinner.

Day 3. Visit the Mattancherry Palace and the oldest Jewish synagogue in India. Take a Keralan cooking class in the afternoon and enjoy classical Indian dance on a rooftop restaurant with dinner.

Day 4. With a 6.30 am start, so we will arrive at the elephant camp in time for their breakfast and river bath. Then straight to the waterfalls before visiting the spice farm. From there up to Munnar, the hill station established by the British in the 1800's. Relax in the late afternoon enjoying the sun setting over the tea plantations before dinner.

Day 5. After a leisurely breakfast we explore this picturesque area with a visit to Echo Point, the local markets, the Tea Museum, plus some light trekking through the tea fields. Enjoy the fresh mountain air and the endless green vistas.

Day 6. We drive to Alleppey to board a Keralan luxury houseboat for an overnight cruise exploring the tranquil backwaters. Delicious authentic local cuisine on board as we drift through quiet canals lined with coconut palms. We see and meet local villagers living and working in this unique region.
